Dr. Rosenberg is a board-certified Emergency Medicine physician who works at Temple University Hospital in North Philadelphia. She is also the Assistant Dean for Narrative Medicine and Health Humanities at Lewis Katz School of Medicine. Her writing has been published in JAMA, The New York Times, and the Philadelphia Inquirer. She writes and teaches about the doctor-patient relationship, communicating serious news, the impact of suffering on patients and their caregivers, and forensic evidence collection in the Emergency Department.
