

## EM

For those considering EM as an option, try to do IM and surgery early in phase 2 and attempt to complete a 2-week EM elective during phase 2 before the phase 3 lottery in January. Another option would be to do it in later in phase 2 or in the first weeks of phase 3 in April. Note that the 2-week elective is not necessary for those with other exposure to EM—it is okay to jump right into the sub-I in phase 3. It is more for those who wish to first explore the field. PLEASE NOTE THIS IS A SAMPLE SCHEDULE. While the overall course content is an aim prior to graduation, the exact order has significant flexibility. PLEASE BE CERTAIN TO DISCUSS ELECTIVE PLANS WITH YOUR COACH, THE ADSA, ADCA or ADCE AND ONE OR MORE SPECIALTY ADVISORS.

For phase 3, **yellow** courses should be completed before the end of block 4.5 which ends on September 8<sup>th</sup> but can be done in any order.

**Green** courses are examples of non-clinical courses that are well suited for interview season, but can include any listed non-clinical, research or reading elective that can be completed between interview days. The **CAPSTONE** course is a required in-person course only given once per year, in the year of graduation. The non-highlighted courses are examples of things that can be done any time during the year. In phase 3, only one away sub-I is recommended by CORD. **\*is a one week block instead of a 4 week block.**
