Dr. Dickey, PhD, MPH is an Applied Research Scientist in Cancer Epidemiology at the Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa, FL. Dr. Dickey's overall research objective is to investigate cancer associated with a viral infection, and particularly in the immunocompromised setting of HIV with the goal of improving prevention and early detection. In this seminar she will share work she has done towards this goal specifically on Human Papillomavirus (HPV)-associated cancers of the oropharynx and cervix and by using novel molecular methylation-based markers to investigate immunosuppression and epigenetic aging among people living with HIV and cancer.
