Saxby, PhD, RDN, is a postdoctoral research scholar in the Department of Internal Medicine at the University of Iowa, where she investigates the influence of dietary interventions on neurodegenerative diseases through both patient-reported and clinical outcomes. Beyond just this, dietary modifications have the potential to be adjunct therapies to current standard-of-care practices when it comes to many chronic diseases.
