## Epi Seminar Series - COBRE Research In Progress with Terri Lewinson PhD, MSW (She/Her/Hers)



Bio: Dr. Lewinson is an Associate Professor at The Dartmouth Institute for Health Policy and Clinical Practice and in the Department of Epidemiology. As a housing policy researcher and social scientist, she explores environmental conditions in housing that influence health and well-being. She grounds her research in an ecosystems approach and social justice framework.

Talk Description: Dr. Lewinson reports on preliminary findings of her COBRE-funded project that surveyed tobacco smoke exposure and collected salivary cotinine measures among adults residing in Metro Atlanta extended-stay hotels. In her talk, she will share data collection challenges and solutions to data collection and continued approaches for air sampling. Descriptive tables and graphs will highlight findings to date. She will also discuss next steps in the project.
