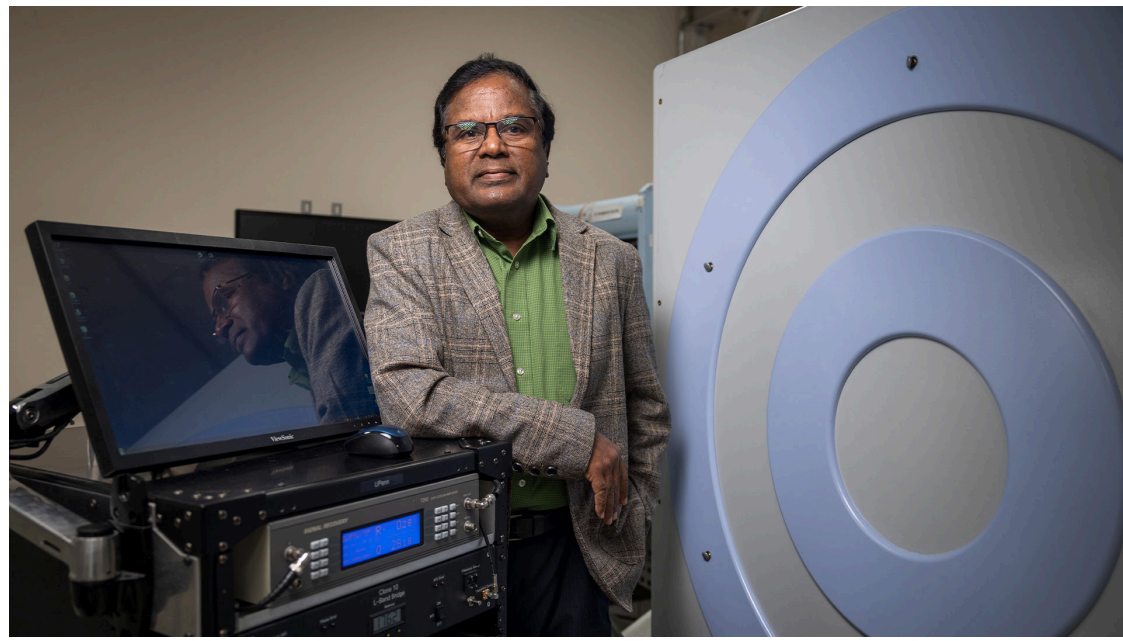

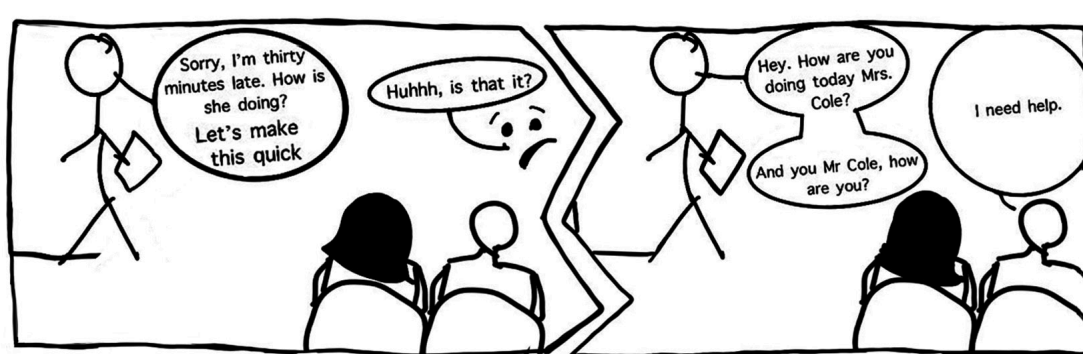
Geisel Professor Receives IES Fellow Award
