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# The Work Up Section

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- Height
- Weight
- Tobacco Use

# Height and Weight

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- Required for Breast, Colorectal, and CML when chemotherapy or other drugs are given
- Required *as available* for all other sites
- Used in calculating BMI for chemotherapy or other drugs
- Different tumors may have different values
- Value should be listed at or around the time of diagnosis
- If not listed on DX date, use what is recorded on the date closest to the DX date and before treatment was started

# Coding Height

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- Enter as a 2-digit number, measured in inches

- Round to the nearest whole number

Example: 62.5 inches = 63 inches

Example:        Feet    Inches

4.0'        48

4' 11"      59

6' 0"        72

Code "98" for 98 inches or greater.

Code "99" for unknown height.

- Note that 1 foot = 12 inches

# Coding Weight

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- Entered as a 3-digit number, measured in pounds
- Round to the nearest whole number

Example: 155.2 pounds = 155

Example:

| <u>Kg</u> | <u>Lbs.</u> | <u>Code</u> |
|-----------|-------------|-------------|
| 32        | 70          | 070         |
| 75        | 165         | 165         |
| 95        | 209         | 209         |

Code “999” for unknown weight.

- Enter leading 0 if weight is <100 lbs.
- Note that 1 kg = 2.2 pounds
- Can also use the following on-line conversion calculator:

# Tobacco Use

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- Required for Breast, Colorectal, and CML
- Required for all other sites *as available*
- Record past or current use of tobacco
- There are FOUR different data items
  - Tobacco Use – Cigarette
  - Tobacco Use – Other Smoke: Smoking tobacco products other than cigarettes (e.g., pipes, cigars, etc.)
  - Smokeless tobacco products (e.g., chewing tobacco, snuff, etc.)
  - Tobacco, NOS

# Coding Tobacco Use

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| <u>Code</u> | <u>Definition</u>   |
|-------------|---|
| 0           | Never used  |
| 1           | Current user  |
| 2           | Former user, quit within one year of date of diagnosis          |
| 3           | Former user, quit more than one year prior to date of diagnosis |
| 4           | Former user, unknown when quit                                  |
| 9           | Unknown/not stated/no smoking specifics provided                |
