

Medical Student Radiology Triage Program (MSRTP) Agreement

The Medical Student Radiology Triage Program (MSRTP) is a DHMC Department of Radiology program which involves students working with the on-call radiology resident during weekday evenings and weekends. Students eligible to participate are DMS 3rd and 4th year students in good, institutional standing. Student compensation is \$10/hr. Student duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Answering calls from clinicians and other hospital personnel
- Establishing the nature and urgency of imaging requests or inquiries
- Gathering pertinent patient medical information (e.g., brief medical history, labs, prior imaging & workup)
- Triageing all imaging requests and coordinating the approval, scheduling and protocoling of requests
- Communicating results with the appropriate clinicians or clinical services

Students are expected to comply with the following requirements:

- Cover a minimum of 10 shifts during an academic year
- Arrange for a replacement in the event of shift cancellation, unless sick or dealing with personal loss or injury
- Avoid conflicts with clinical rotation obligations when choosing shifts dates: MSRTP doesn't constitute a valid reason to neglect required clerkship/clinical rotation duties
- Exhibit the same level of professionalism and adherence to patient privacy rules as required during clinical rotations

By signing this agreement, the signatory acknowledges full understanding of the required duties and rules and agrees to the terms above. Failure to perform or adhere to these requirements may result in the signatory being expelled from the MSRTP program.
