### Prerequisites

All elective decisions and timing are at the discretion of the Program Director.

### Description

The purpose of this rotation is to enhance the education experience of residents in Diagnostic Radiology through participation in the clinical care and treatment of patients in the outpatient setting in the greater Manchester area. The staff at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Manchester have a clinical faculty appointment at DHMC. All policies and procedures of the residency program apply to the rotation including teaching, supervision, and evaluation of radiology residents.

### Elective Aims

1. Introduce DHMC radiology residents to all facets of a multispecialty clinic.
2. Interpret and manage a diverse and busy caseload in an urban community environment.
3. Improve interpersonal and communication skills as they pertain to interacting with alert, concerned, ambulatory outpatients and providers.
4. Perform image guided procedures appropriate to the local practice.

### Learning Objectives

1. Interpret a wide range of imaging exams from a more diverse urban population.
2. Improve skills in commonly performed image guided procedures.
3. Manage higher work flow volumes than are typically experienced in academic practice
4. Develop the time management and prioritization skills required to efficiently work with a mixed modality work lists.
5. Develop communication and consultative skills as these pertain to urban imaging facilities.

### Duties

1. Perform preliminary interpretations of all imaging modalities under the direction of the attending radiologist.
2. Complete protocols for upcoming imaging exams.
3. Perform, skill level appropriate, image guided procedures under the direction of the attending radiologist.

**Assignments**

Assignments will be defined by the elective supervisor at the practice according to work needs and resident expertise.

**Suggested Reading**

No specific reading is assigned for this elective. The resident should continue with their general radiology reading.

**Evaluation**

An E Value evaluation will be assigned to the supervisor at the end of the elective.
