- Non-Emergency Examples**
- Feelings of burnout, stress, anxiety
 - Pattern of missing classes and assignments
 - Well-being: Financial, food, and/or housing insecurities

- Crisis Examples**
- Suicidal thoughts and/or plans to hurt oneself or others
 - Recent traumatic experience
 - Unable to perform daily tasks, such as not being able to eat or sleep for several days
