Eligibility & Criteria for Student Inductees

Eligibility:

- Have all high pass grades or all high pass grades except for 1 pass grade by the end of the winter term.
- Stay in good academic standing until graduation.
- Demonstrate leadership in health and health care practice, research and service.
- Be a current MPH graduate student
 - o Residential program: Have completed summer, fall, and winter terms.
 - o Hybrid program: Have completed one academic year plus summer, fall, and winter terms

Application Process:

Student Records will pull transcript to verify records

- Complete application form
- Respond to three short answers demonstrating your leadership potential in health and health care practice, research and service
- Provide current resume or CV
- Submit the documents online **after** spring break (deadlines will be shared in the invitation email to each student)

Decision Process:

The Delta Omega Executive Committee is responsible for governance of the society, as well as advising on issues related to the society's mission and management. [Geisel](#)

Election Committee Members

All submissions will be:

- Independently reviewed by each committee member
- Reviewed with a holistic view of the entire application
- After the initial independent review, the executive committee members meet as a group to:
 - Discuss application
 - Review sum scores
 - Summarize comments
 - Discuss any questions they have
 - Hold one additional meeting to make a final decision

Induction Notification:
